

Wood, Water, Wildlife, and Recreation: A Forestry Field Day!

Presented by Michigan Conservation Districts, Forestry Assistance Program, American Tree Farm System, and Michigan Agriculture Environmental Assurance Program



During this workshop you will learn about different factors to consider when making management decisions on your forested (and non-forested) property. Specific topics will include defining your objectives, tree species and what they require, revenue from harvesting trees, wildlife habitat, diversity of species and structure, environmental quality, and invasive species. The field day will also introduce the American Tree Farm System (ATFS), a voluntary national forest certification program for family forest owners, as well as the Michigan Agriculture Environmental Assurance Program (MAEAP) Forest, Wetlands, and Habitat A*Syst (FWH*A*Syst), a verification program for Michigan landowners. The workshop will include an indoor presentation and a field tour of a property with different types of forest management and that is certified in ATFS and verified in MAEAP FWH*A*Syst. Continuing Education credits through the Society of American Foresters, as well as MAEAP Phase 1 Education Credit, will be available for those who attend.
